What to do in the Event of a Work-Related Injury/Illness

If a true EMERGENCY, call 911. Person is transported to the appropriate Hospital Emergency Department. Employee should also contact the <u>Occupational Health</u> <u>Nurse Practitioner (OHNP) on-call at 404-686-5500 PIC # 50464</u>, as soon as possible.

1. First Aid:

- Clean any wound thoroughly with soap and water for 15 minutes or use the eyewash station for 15 minutes.
- 2. Employee completes an "Accident/Injury Entry" on PeopleSoft
- 3. <u>If unable to report via PeopleSoft for whatever reason (including students or other persons not on the payroll), contact Occupational Injury Management (OIM)</u>:

4. <u>Directions to Occupational Injury Management at EUH - Wing D, Room</u> <u>D219</u>:

- Entering the Emory Hospital from Asbury Circle
 - Go to the second floor and go half way down the main corridor.
 - Turn left at the D Wing sign and follow the signs to D219 Employee Health Services.

5. <u>If any of the following symptoms present over the next 2 weeks, report back to</u> <u>OIM</u>:

- a. Redness, swelling, pain, discomfort, or discharge at any wound or exposure site.
- b. Fever or flu-like disease possibly accompanied by a skin rash or swollen lymph nodes.
