

Dr Chris Scharer named Scientific Director of the Emory Integrated Genomics Core (EIGC)

The Emory Integrated Genomics Core (EIGC) is pleased to announce that Dr. Chris Scharer has been named its new Scientific Director.

EIGC is one of the Emory Integrated Core Facilities (EICF, <http://www.cores.emory.edu>) with joint support and oversight provided by the Emory University School of Medicine and the Winship Cancer Institute of Emory University. EIGC is a CLIA-certified lab, serving over 140 investigators which span across 27 departments.

Dr. Scharer is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Microbiology and Immunology. His research focuses on the transcriptional and epigenetic regulation of the immune system. His lab uses genomics, traditional molecular biology, and cellular immunology to study the antibody response and mechanisms of immune memory.
